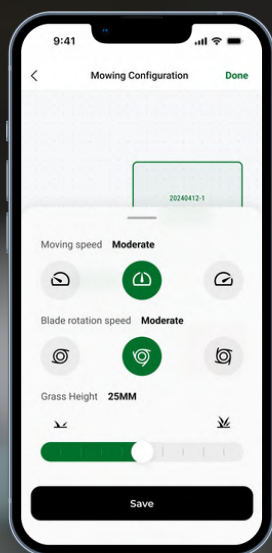
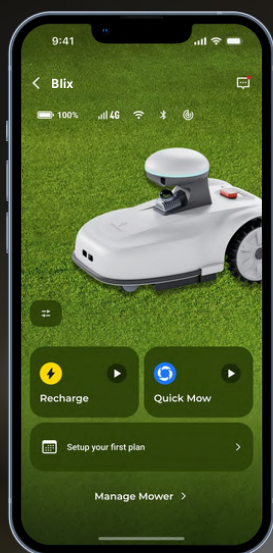
Neater lawn, healthier growth

A built-in rain sensor tells Blix when to pause or skip scheduled mowing.



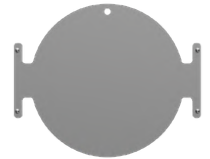
Easy to clean

IPX5 water resistance makes cleanup easy. Just rinse Blix with a garden hose² to wash away grass and debris.

² Tested under ideal conditions: water sprayed from any angle, below 30 kPa pressure, at a distance of 3 meters.

Quick blade maintenance

Remove the cutting deck to swap the blade assembly fast. Unscrew to rotate or replace blades. Retractable blades help reduce damage from small impacts, like rocks or twigs.



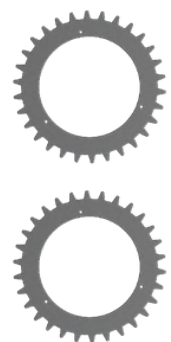
Climbs slopes up to 65%

Blix climbs slopes up to 65% or 33°, while the cutting deck follows lawn contours to help protect the grass.



Grip for sloped lawns

Blix's wheels are built for confident movement on slopes. Add wheel spikes for extra traction on wet grass and better stability on inclines.
